

HaddenLoch Rules and Regulations

Welcome to HaddenLoch. We have developed these regulations in order to ensure your safety and satisfaction. We ask that you observe and respect the rules so that all may have a safe and enjoyable experience.

Management reserves the right to change any of the pricing, rules and regulations listed here or posted in the barn at any time.

Barn Hours

When a trainer is on-site and/or Tuesday-Friday: 8:30am – 6:00pm
When a trainer is NOT on-site and/or Saturday, Sunday: 8:30am – 5:00pm
Closed Monday

At the time the barn is closing all horses must be returned to their stalls or paddocks.

We understand the occasional need to be at HaddenLoch outside of normal business hours. Arrangements may be made in advance by speaking to management for such situations.

GENERAL BARN RULES

- Smoking is prohibited in the barns.
- No running or shouting in the barn or near the horses.
- The main gate into HaddenLoch property must be kept closed at all times. Even if you are dropping someone off or leaving for only a few minutes the gate **MUST** be closed after you drive through.
- The speed limit on the barn property is **5mph**. This will be **STRICTLY** enforced. Riders often cool their horses out by riding down the driveway. **EXTREME** caution is to be used when driving anywhere on the property.
- Keep the barn clean. If your horse leaves manure it should be cleaned up immediately even if you are on your way to a lesson.
- All grooming/tacking areas must be swept immediately after use.
- All wash racks must be hosed off immediately after use.
- Please check all the boards at HaddenLoch when visiting to view updates, messages, or invoices.
- **Absolutely NO jumping unless you are having a lesson.**

BOARDING

- Stable management will assign stalls and tack storage areas to boarders.
- All tack stored in the tack room is to be kept on your designated racks and trunks.
- Each boarder is allowed one saddle rack per horse.
- Because of limited space tack and equipment storage is available **ONLY** for boarders, trainers, staff and individuals who lease a horse.
- All supplements must be stored in the feed room. Boarders must supply single daily doses of the horse's daily supplements. Boarders can either supply SmartPaks or labeled baggies.
- Horses should not be left unattended in any area.
- Scheduled lessons have priority in the ring. If you intend on hacking your horse during lesson times you must have approval from that instructor prior to the start of the lesson.

- When riding at will in the arenas always pass left shoulder to left shoulder and if approaching from behind announce “inside” or “outside” to the rider you are passing.

LEASING / HACKING

- Individuals who lease a horse may ride that horse only on the day or days on which they lease.
- The horse you lease may be ridden for 1 hour only. During that time it is your responsibility to make sure the horse is properly warmed up and cooled down. During your riding you should be attentive to the fact that the horse is not overworked or overheated.
- When riding at will in the arenas always pass left shoulder to left shoulder and if approaching from behind announce “inside” or “outside” to the rider you are passing.

LESSON POLICIES

- There is a 24 hour cancellation policy for all lessons. Except in the event of an emergency please contact the instructor at least 24 hours before your scheduled lesson time to cancel or reschedule. Failure to do so will result in being charged the full lesson price.
- Lessons may be canceled at the discretion of the instructor for inclement weather. If the instructor has not contacted you to discuss cancellation of the lesson please arrive at your scheduled time. You will not be charged if a lesson is canceled due to weather.
- We offer competent adult supervision for the duration of the student’s lesson. However, it is not always possible to provide supervision outside of the lesson time. If you are not available to supervise your child while he or she is at the barn they must remain within the sight of a responsible adult.
- No one under 18 is allowed in the paddocks without direct staff supervision.
- HaddenLoch grooming supplies should be returned to the correct bins after use.
- HaddenLoch tack used by any rider must be cleaned and put away after use.
- When riding at will in the arenas always pass left shoulder to left shoulder and if approaching from behind announce “inside” or “outside” to the rider you are passing.

RIDING

- Approved helmets are to be worn at all times when mounted.
- Appropriate riding attire is required when mounted. This includes long pants, boots with a heel and an approved helmet if under 21 years of age. We understand that Florida summers are hot. Tank tops are allowed as long as they have at least a 1” wide strap and shirts should be fitted or tucked in so that the instructor can judge appropriate back position. No shorts while mounted. Closed toed shoes are required at all times when around the horses. No flip-flops while handling or near the horses.
- Respect and caring for our horses is paramount. Please understand that a student’s responsibilities may continue after the lesson time has ended. The horse may need to be hosed, sponged, cooled out properly, grazed or blanketed depending on the work done or the season. This is the responsibility of the RIDER to ensure the horse is properly taken care of. Please allow enough time in your schedules to accommodate this.
- For safety long hair is required to be pulled back into a ponytail, pigtails, or placed underneath the helmet. Long hair can impair vision.
- When riding at will in the arenas always pass left shoulder to left shoulder and if approaching from behind announce “inside” or “outside” to the rider you are passing.

FAMILY AND VISITORS

- Visitors are welcome during barn hours. They should check in with management immediately upon arrival to sign a release form.
- Visiting dogs are welcome provided that they are friendly to all people and all other animals. Owners are responsible for keeping their dogs away from horses and OUT of the riding rings at all times.
